- * Student will understand the fractions as parts of a whole, identifying and representing fractions using models and symbols, comparing and ordering fractions, and performing basic operations like addition and subtraction with like denominators.
- * Student will understand the concept of decimals and their relationship to fractions, specifically up to the hundredths place. Students should be able to read, write, and compare decimals, as well as understand their connection to place value.

Learning Outcome:-

- * Students should understand the concept of decimals, recognizing decimal notation, relating decimals to fractions, identifying place values in decimals, and comparing and ordering decimals. Students should also be able to convert between fractions and decimals, and solve simple word problems involving decimals.
- * Student will identify fraction, representing, and comparing simple fractions (like halves, quarters, and three-fourths). Students will also learn to recognize equivalent fractions and understand their relationship to the whole.
